

# Bylaw # 901

BEING a By-Law of the Town of Carstairs in the Province of Alberta, to regulate streets and public places in the corporate limits of the Town of Carstairs and the depositing or accumulation of snow, ice and dust.

WHEREAS, the Town of Carstairs has been authorized by the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M 26-1, with amendments to pass bylaws;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Carstairs in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled in Council, enacts as follows:

1. The owner or occupier of any premise within the town of Carstairs shall remove and clear away all snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction from the sidewalk adjoining such premises within twenty four (24) hours of such snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction being deposited thereon, and upon failure thereof, the Council may provide for the clearing of such sidewalks, at the owners expense, including the sidewalks of non-residents and in the case of nonpayment of the expenses thereof by the owner or occupant, thirty (30) days after demand has been made by the Town , such expenses may be charged by the Town against such premises as a special assessment to be recovered in a like manner as real property taxes, including an additional charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) added to the actual cost of removing the snow, ice or obstruction.
2. No owner shall place or allow to be placed any obstruction on any sidewalk, street or roadway, including snow, ice or dirt, which has been removed from a property or sidewalk without the written consent of the Town of Carstairs. Snow, ice or dirt or any other obstruction placed or caused to be placed on any sidewalk, street or roadway shall be immediately removed by the Owner. Failure to remove the snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction will result in the Town of Carstairs removing the material with all costs of removal, plus a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) fine, to be at the expense of the owner and this expense may be recovered as a special assessment to be recovered in a like manner as real property taxes owing.
3. If snow, ice or dirt or any other obstruction is placed on the sidewalks, streets or laneways by the Town of Carstairs it is the responsibility of the Town of Carstairs to remove said materials.

This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.
