- K. Williscroft provided the Land Use Redesignation Report. The subject site is located within the southwest portion of the Kitstone Commons Conceptual scheme Phase One. There was a technical error in the land use amendment application previously submitted and approved by Council, therefore LUR-23-02 seeks to redesignate the lands recently designated Special Low Density Residential District (R1S) to Low Density Residential District – Single Detached District (R1). The Low Density Residential District – Single Detached District (R1) is intended to accommodate single detached residential dwellings. The use of this district creates a continuous symmetry with the adjacent Havensfield lots to the west. In summary, the proposed redesignation rectifies a clerical error made on behalf of the applicant. It is recommended that the Land Use Bylaw Redesignation be

approved.
